University of Chicago Responsibilities	Student Responsibilities
Respond to the student's request for an accommodation.	Self-identify to Student Disability Services (SDS) as an individual with a disability.
Determine a student's eligibility to receive reasonable accommodations (may take up to 2-3 weeks to receive a	Meet with SDS staff and provide them with supporting documentation
formal determination)	Request reasonable accommodations in a timely manner when needed
Develop a plan with the student for implementation of approved reasonable accommodations	Interactively work with SDS and the academic division as necessary to determine the appropriate
Coordinate and provide reasonable accommodations that enable students to access academic programs, services or activities sponsored by the University	accommodations Communicate to SDS, faculty and/or the Disability Liaison as appropriate regarding the implementation of approved accommodations.
